The school receives a grant (Pupil Deprivation Grant - PDG) from the government for each child eligible for a free school meal. It's statutory for the school to publish how we spend this grant.

Historically these pupils have performed well at Ysgol Friog.

Ysgol Friog PDG Grant 2015/16: £7,950

We have detailed plans to use the grant as follows:

Increase teaching assistants hours to work with individual and groups of pupils.

Ensure opportunities for pupils to gain a wide variety of experiences during schools hours and as part of extra-curricular opportunities in after school clubs.

Ensure effective use of Literacy and Numeracy resources (including IT and online resources) in classrooms, outdoor classrooms and at home.

Prepare and deliver sessions for parents to better understand numeracy within the school.

Continue to develop a 'ready to learn' package for Nursery and Reception pupils and their families before school and during the first years of school.

Use Reading sacks and numeracy boxes at home to develop access to resources at home.
