WE'RE KEEN TO HEAR FROM CLUSTERS AND/OR SCHOOLS THAT ARE INTERESTED IN PILOTING AN EVIDENCE-INFORMED NUMERACY PROGRAMME WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF WARWICK AND GWE

The Inclusive Teaching of Early Numeracy (i-TEN) programme is an evidence-informed maths intervention based on *Maths Recovery*. It is designed to support the development of numeracy skills for struggling learners who are not currently making the expected progress in mathematics and numeracy. i-TEN has been adapted to be accessible for pupils in mainstream settings, and especially for younger learners in primary schools with ALN. We would like to work with ten schools in 2024-25 to evaluate the impact of i-TEN with small groups of learners in mainstream settings.
